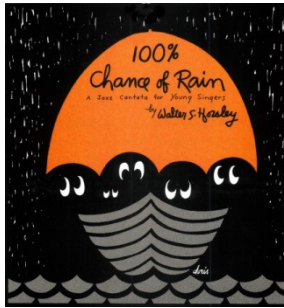


**Brianna Johnson, Choreographer**

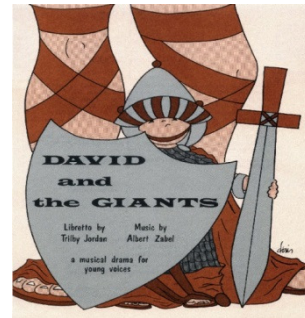
