September 30 and October 1

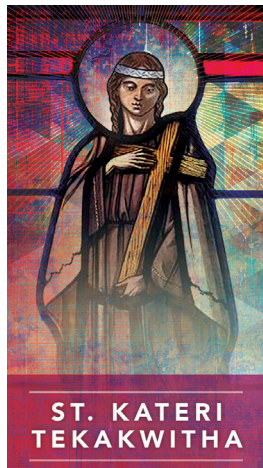

September 30 is Canada's Truth and Reconciliation Day. This day, called "Orange Shirt Day," was created as an opportunity to discuss the effects of residential schools and their legacy. It honors the experiences of Indigenous Peoples, celebrates resilience, and affirms a commitment that every child matters. Our prayers go out to all those harmed, the intergenerational trauma carried through the families and the destruction of culture and language over the decades.

• Prayer Service, Pilgrimage Walk, and Lunch

Gather at the Basilica of Saint Mary at 9 a.m. on Saturday, Oct. 1, for an opening prayer with a new icon of Blessed Kateri Tekakwitha. Our pilgrimage begins by bringing our intentions regarding the trauma of the residential boarding schools for American Indians, lifting them to God through the intercession of St. Kateri Tekakwitha and

Servant of God Black Elk.

Walk of 2.5 miles from the Basilica to Cristo Rey Jesuit High School with our intentions of this penitential pilgrimage.
