Families will begin moving into Emerson Village in November. The building, on 18th and Emerson Aves. N., will provide 40 high-quality apartment homes for families whose annual income is less than \$30,000. It will offer individualized, on-site support services for residents.

Emerson Village is a project of the Beacon Interfaith Housing Collaborative. Beacon is made up of congregations – including Ascension – that advance equitable housing policy, provide funding for supportive services, and support the creation of new, deeply affordable homes.

Our new neighbors will need household items as they settle into their new homes. Member congregations are collecting items, and Ascension is pitching in by providing some Laundry/Bath Baskets.

Here's how to help.
Shop for the following items:

- 2 laundry baskets
- 2 bath mats
- Facial tissue
- Toilet paper
- Wet wipes
- paper towels
- Bath towels
- 2 shower curtains with hooks
- Laundry detergent
- Dryer sheets

Bring them to mass on Oct. 20 or 27.
You can buy all or some. Members of our Social Justice Group will put the baskets together and deliver them.

The Eucharist, Divinization, and the Regeneration of the World

Over the past two years the U.S Catholic Church has celebrated a Eucharistic Revival culminating in the July 2024 National Eucharistic Congress. The Congress used the language of "renewal" to describe the power of the Eucharist for the Church. This same language was hallmark for Dom Virgil Michel, O.S.B. in his theology of the Eucharist and the power of liturgy to renew and regenerate both the Church and the faithful. Michel understood himself as drawing deeply from the theological and liturgical tradition, including the thought of Thomas Aquinas on the Eucharist and the nature of the Church.

Join us for a day of reflection on Saint Thomas's understanding of the Eucharist as a polyvalent sign, sacrament, and sacrifice which, when received through the liturgical lens of Virgil Michel, orients us to the ecclesial renewal envisioned by the Eucharistic Congress. We will examine the ways in which a retrieval of tradition demands personal and ecclesial growth into the full measure of the Body of Christ.
