The song “We Three Kings” details the gifts of the Magi, but do you know what you’re singing?

“Born a king on Bethlehem’s plan, gold I bring to crown Him again.” This one is the most straightforward - gold symbolizes the Kingship of Christ.

“Myrrh is mine: its bitter perfume breathes a life of gathering gloom.” Myrrh is an embalming spice. Already at Christ’s birth, we have the symbolic reminder of his death.

“Frankincense to offer have I. Incense owns a deity nigh.” In many religious traditions, incense symbolizes prayers rising to heaven. In some pagan traditions, it is thought to help “call down” the deity. The gift of frankincense symbolizes Jesus’ role as the Great High Priest, sanctifying the world through his sacrifice.

La canción “Nosotros los Reyes Magos” detalla los regalos de los Reyes Magos, pero ¿sabes lo que estás cantando?


“Nacido un rey en el plano de Belén, oro traigo para coronarle de nuevo”. Éste es el más directo: el oro simboliza la realeza de Cristo.

Epiphany | Epifanía

“Mirra es mía: su perfume amargo respira una vida de penumbra creciente”. La mirra es una especia para

embalsamar. Ya en el nacimiento de Cristo, tenemos el recuerdo simbólico de su muerte.

“Incienso para ofrecer tengo. Incienso posee una deidad cercana”. En muchas tradiciones religiosas, el incienso simboliza las plegarias que se elevan al cielo. En algunas tradiciones paganas, se cree que ayuda a “llamar” a la deidad. El regalo del incienso simboliza el papel de Jesús como Gran Sumo Sacerdote, que santifica el mundo mediante su sacrificio.
